

INFORMATION PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 13 OF EU REGULATION NO. 679/2016 ("GDPR")

This Privacy Notice describes which of your personal data are collected by CEPI S.p.A., for which purposes and how they are processed. Below you will also find the information you need to exercise your rights under the GDPR.

In general, we collect your data when you browse the website www.cepisilos.com (hereinafter the "Website") and when you contact us through the Website, and when you interact with us through our social pages on LinkedIn, Facebook, Instagram and YouTube (hereinafter the "Social Pages"). Please note that the personal data collected during these processes will be processed as set out below.

This Privacy Notice is provided only for the CEPI S.p.A. website and not for any other websites that the user may access through links, for whose content and policies CEPI S.p.A. is not responsible.

Please note that specific privacy notices relating to particular services or features may be included within the pages of the Website (for example, the notice dedicated to the whistleblowing channel or the candidate privacy notice available in the "Work with us" section).

1. Who processes your data: data controller

CEPI S.p.A., VAT No. 01746760402, with registered office at Via Selva no. 18, Zona Industriale La Selva - 47122 Forlì (FC), e-mail: cepi@cepisilos.com, is the data controller of your personal data ("Controller").

With regard only to the data collected through our Social Pages, LinkedIn, Meta Platforms Inc and Google Ireland Limited are joint controllers of your personal data. For further information, please read their privacy notices.

2. Which data we process - Type of data processed

Your contact details. We store the information you provide to us (for example, contact details, first name and surname, e-mail address) when you contact us through the form published on the Website or through the e-mail addresses published on the Website.

Information about your use of the Website and your activities on the Website. Your use of the Website involves the processing of data relating to the browser and device you are using and your IP address (this is the number that identifies a specific device on the internet and is necessary for your device to communicate with websites). We may also analyze which website you came from and which actions you performed on the Website.

3. Where we obtain your data - Data collection methods:

Directly from you. For example, when you contact us through the e-mail addresses published on the Website and submit a query, when you fill in a form on the Website, when you request assistance, a quotation or subscription to the newsletter.

Through the use of the Website features. We use cookies and other technologies in order to collect data about your use and to better target promotional activities. For more information, please read the Cookie Policy.

4. Why and for how long we process your data - Purposes and legal basis of data processing; retention period

a) To respond to your requests collected by e-mail or received through the "Contacts" form or the "Assistance and Spare Parts" sections, or collected through the Social Pages. For example, we will use your data to respond to your requests received by e-mail or through the forms published on the Website ("Contacts" and "Assistance and Spare Parts"), through the addresses published on the Website.

The legal basis for this processing is the performance of a contract to which the data subject is party or the performance of pre-contractual obligations, and the retention period is equal to the time necessary to follow up on the data subject's requests.

b) To subscribe you to the newsletter. When registering for the newsletter, the User's e-mail address is automatically added to a contact list to which e-mail messages may be sent containing information, including

commercial and promotional information, relating to the Controller and related activities. The legal basis for this processing is the data subject's consent.

c) To prevent or monitor unlawful conduct or to protect and enforce rights. We may use your data to prevent the infringement of our intellectual property rights (for example, counterfeiting of our trademarks and/or those of our partners), theft or other unlawful conduct, as permitted by applicable law.

The legal basis for this processing is the legitimate interest of the Controller. The retention period for your data is equal to the time reasonably necessary to enforce our rights from the moment we become aware of the unlawful conduct or its potential occurrence.

5. Nature of the provision of personal data

For purposes a) and c) referred to in the previous paragraph, the provision of data is necessary. For purpose b) referred to in the previous paragraph, the provision of data is optional and free, as well as subject to your explicit consent, which may also be withdrawn at any time. Any refusal, however, will make it impossible for the Controller to subscribe you to the newsletter.

6. Where your data are processed - data transfer

The data will be processed and stored at the Controller's offices and on its IT systems. We may use service providers or rely on companies acting as data processors under agreements compliant with Article 28 GDPR. Where such providers are located in Third Countries, they operate on the basis of standard contractual clauses in accordance with the European Commission decision on protection clauses or pursuant to an adequacy decision of the European Commission on the level of data protection. These parties receive only the personal data necessary to perform their functions and may use them solely to provide such services on our behalf or to comply with legal requirements. You may obtain information on transfers to third countries by writing to the Controller at the address indicated above.

Only with regard to the data collected on our Social Pages, such data will be stored on the respective platforms, in accordance with their privacy policies, which we invite you to consult.

7. With whom we share your data - recipients of personal data

Without prejudice to the fact that, where required by law, we will obtain your prior consent and carry out any formalities required by law, we may share your data with the following third parties (also acting as data processors):

Our service providers. We may share your personal data with third parties so that they can provide services to us. Such parties will act as data processors, and we will enter into an agreement with them compliant with Article 28 GDPR to protect your data. These parties receive only the data necessary to perform their functions and may use them solely to provide such services on our behalf or to comply with legal requirements. You may obtain the complete list of such data processors pursuant to Article 28 GDPR by writing to the Controller at the addresses indicated above.

Where permitted or required by law, we may also share personal data requested by a government body or by another authorized person or organization in order to protect or exercise our rights or the rights of third parties, or to limit or prevent fraud and other unlawful conduct.

8. Minors

The Website is not intended for persons under 18 years of age, but is intended for an adult audience. If you are a parent or guardian and believe that your child has provided us with data, you may contact us.

9. Your rights

You may contact the Controller to request access to your personal data, rectification or erasure of such data or restriction of processing, to object to processing and to request the portability of your data, where processing is carried out by automated means; you may also withdraw your consent at any time (this will not affect the lawfulness of processing based on consent given before withdrawal).

When exercising your right of access, you have the right to know whether your data are being processed, the purpose of the processing, the categories of data processed, the recipients or categories of recipients to whom your data are disclosed (and, if they are located in a third country, on the basis of which safeguards), the retention period for your data (or the criteria used to determine that period), whether automated processing is being carried out (for example through profiling) and the logic involved in such processing, and the source of the data (where they were not initially collected by us). You may exercise your rights by contacting the Controller at the addresses indicated above.

You have the right to lodge a complaint with the competent supervisory authority.

You may also exercise your rights in relation to the processing of personal data carried out through our Social Pages by contacting the individual platforms in accordance with their respective privacy policies.

11. What we do if we change this Privacy Notice

We may make changes to our privacy policy. We will also publish an updated version on the Website. It will have a date different from the one indicated below. Please consult the Website periodically for updates.
